## Conditions of Burial – Important Notice

Barrowby Burial Ground is a lawned burial ground. By signing this form, the applicant confirms that they have read and accepted the Council's current Burial Ground Regulations and Conditions of Burial.

The applicant understands and accepts that:

1. No planting of any kind is permitted within the grave space, including plants, shrubs, bushes, bulbs or trees.
2. The Council reserves the right to remove, without notice, any unauthorised planting or items from the grave space and to re-turf the area where necessary.
3. Temporary wooden crosses are permitted for up to 18 months from the date of burial. After that time they must be removed, unless the Council has agreed otherwise in exceptional circumstances.
4. Any permanent memorial must comply with the Council's Memorial Regulations and must be approved by the Council before installation.
5. All new memorials must include an approved plinth, base or integral area for flowers and permitted ornaments so that the burial ground can be maintained safely and respectfully.
6. Flowers and permitted ornaments must be placed only on the plinth or within the memorial footprint, and not on the surrounding grassed area.
7. Memorials may only be installed by a suitably qualified memorial mason in accordance with the Council's current memorial requirements.
8. The person signing this form confirms that they are the holder of the Exclusive Right of Burial, or are otherwise authorised to make the burial arrangements and accept these conditions.
9. The person signing this form accepts responsibility for the applicable burial fees and any related charges.
