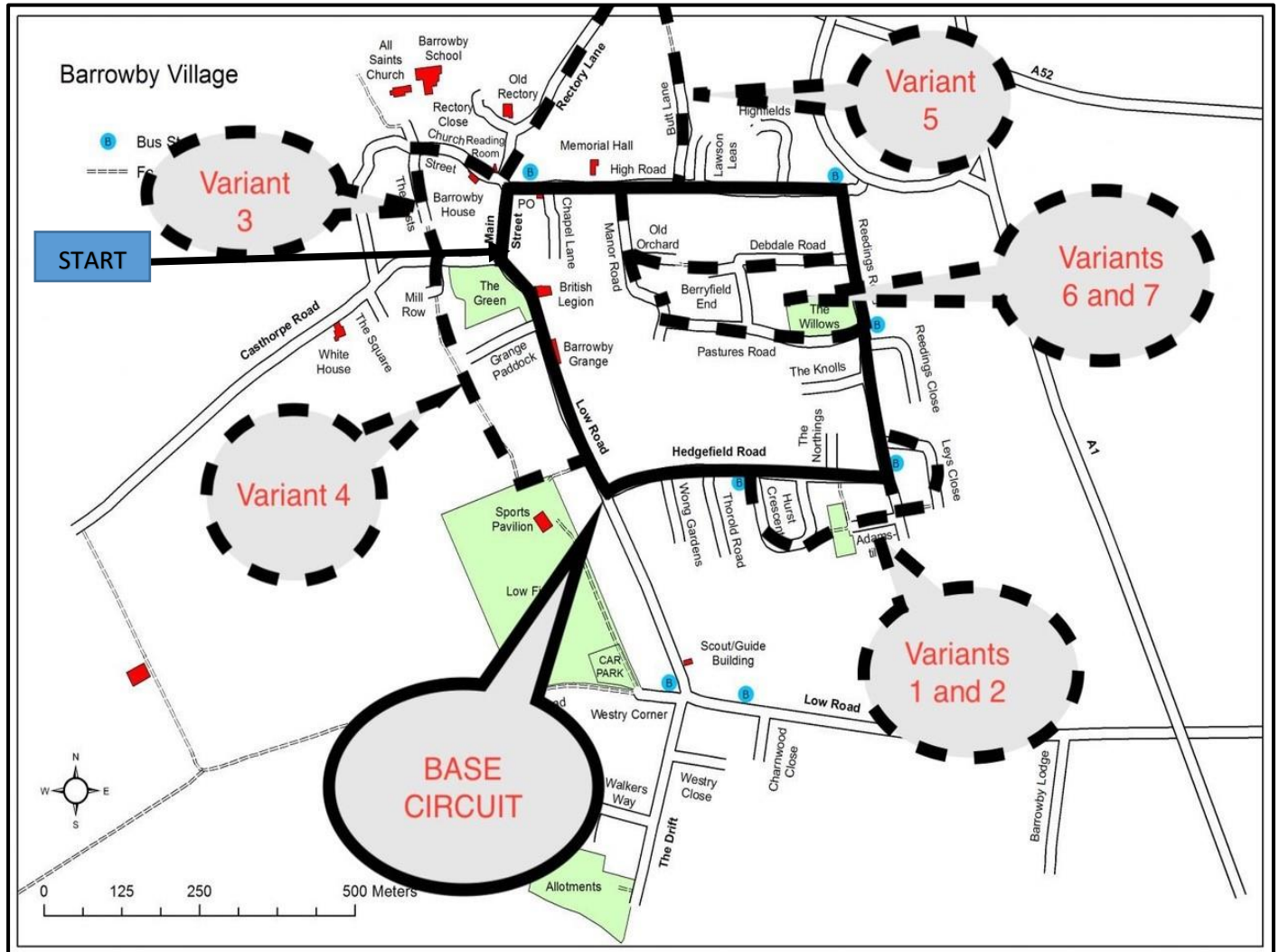


## BARROWBY JITTIES AND BYWAYS

Leisurely, suitable for all ages. Walks on pavements and footpaths within the village. Base circuit plus 7 variants. Distances from 1.5 miles to 2.5 miles

All walks are circular and start at the Village Green (Stevens Gutter) facing the Butchers.

Barrowby is full of jitties and little byways connecting the village together. Do you know them all? If you are interested in the history of the village and surrounding area download the Barrowby Heritage Walks as well.



**Base circuit (1½ miles).** Start at the village green facing the butchers and go right down Low Road, then turn left onto Hedgefield Road. At the end turn left onto Reedings Road and carry on to the end at High Road. Turn left and continue to the White Swan PH, turn left and proceed down Main Street back to the green.

**Variants: these can increase the distance by up to 1 mile or they can be used to make up longer circular walks**

1. Off Hedgefield Road turn right into Hurst Crescent and take the jitty between nos. 11 and 13, to the Adamstiles play park. Then either take the jitty on the left at the top of the Park back onto Hedgefield Road coming out between nos. 20 and 22, or continue onto Reedings Road, turning left to join the original route.
2. Opposite the end of Adamstiles there is a jitty onto Leys Close which returns to Reedings Road, turn right and this can be taken to extend the walk a little.

3. When at the White Swan crossroads go straight across from High Road down Church Street turning left at the entrance to the Old Hall and go down the jitty called the Posts to Casthorpe Road, turn left to arrive back at the Green.
4. Alternatively when you reach the end of the Posts jitty (in variant 3) cross straight over to Mill Row. At the end of the metalled road continue along a grass path to Lowfield turning left alongside the hedge and onto a path leading to Low Road opposite Chartwell. Turn left on Low Road and back to the Green.
5. When on High Road, opposite nos. 23/27 go down Butt Lane (marked as unadopted). The first part is metalled but turns to grass about halfway along until it reaches the A52. Immediately turn sharp left onto Rectory Lane and continue to the White Swan crossroads, carry straight on down Main Street to the Green.
6. From Reedings Road to High Road, you can turn left onto Pastures Road, then right onto Manor Road following this road to a jitty onto High Road, nearly opposite the Memorial Hall. Turn left back to the White Swan crossroads then left onto Main Street back to the green.
7. Alternatively you can go a little further along Reedings Road and turn left into Debdale Road. Follow this and continue straight on to Berryfield End, through a jitty to Old Orchard, and on to Manor Road. Turn right and proceed to High Road through the jitty as above.
