# B.I.G. The Results Are In...

### What did the survey tell us about our community's priorities and desires?

- More than 9 in 10 of respondents work in Barrowby or Grantham.
- Respondents would like to have a general store or community shop and a medical centre in our village.
- More than 90% use the Post Office during the year and the retention and improvement of the Memorial Hall is the preferred priority.
- Infill housing is supported IF there is better infrastructure and there was overwhelming support for entering the Best Village Competition (key dates will be in the next newsletter).
- A high percentage thought speeding traffic and parking were problems.
- Many respondents would like to know more about the Parish Council Open Forum 9<sup>th</sup> June see page 2 for details.
- An annual community event would be welcomed with or without beer.
- Respondents were very keen on a community newsletter.

### What happens next?

Thank you to the Parish Council, who are supporting the first issues of the new Parish Newsletter – the first result of the BIG survey.
