#### Pizzas and Playgrounds... Barrowby Playground Equipment Forum Update:

The BPEF has now completed its public consultation with 96 adult questionnaires and 97 children's questionnaires received to date and being analysed. Responses came from the Parish Council open morning, on-line responses and the three after-school sessions, when parents and children enjoyed pizza and squash in exchange for their views. The Forum thanks all those children, parents and grandparents who contributed their views to the consultation.

The next step is the preparation of the grant bid and a decision from the Parish Council as to how much the budget for the two sites covered by the project will be. The Forum will then decide on a list of suitable equipment to meet all age ranges, from the results of the consultation.

#### Sautéed Sprouts

You will need:

100g diced pancetta, roasted until crisp
400g sprouts, blanched and then quartered
50g pine kernels, roasted
1 red onion, sliced
1/2 clove garlic, crushed
1 teaspoon of good pesto
Good splash of double cream

Prepare all of the above ingredients and set aside until time to serve.

## When ready to serve:

- Sauté the sliced red onion with the garlic
- Add the sprouts, pancetta and pine nuts
- Add the teaspoon of pesto and a good splash of double cream to taste
- Combine until heated through, and serve.
