#### **Barrowby Playground Equipment Forum Update:**

Barrowby Playground and Equipment Forum gave a presentation to the Parish Council on Monday 14th December to explain their progress to date in meeting the objectives defined in the terms of reference given by the Parish Council back in August.

Comprehensive tender documents have been drawn up and were discussed after the presentation. These are expected to be formally approved at the January meeting of Parish Council. The tendering process will then begin, together with an application for a £50,000 grant funding, and with these processes completed the work would be expected to begin in late summer 2016. We expect this exciting new project to be completed by the end of the year.
