#### **Around the Parish**

#### Barrowby's Young Bell Ringers in National Competition

On Saturday 2nd July, two Barrowby Bell Ringers took part in the Ringing World National Youth Contest in London. Bethan and Archie Stanley (aged 14 and 12) competed as part of a team of 8 ringers, The Lincolnshire Gamekeepers, who competed against 23 other teams from across the UK. The competition is open to all bell ringers aged 18 and under.

Although The Lincolnshire Gamekeepers did not win the competition, of the A, B or C grades available, they were awarded a B grade with which they were very pleased.

Whilst in London they had the opportunity to ring on the famous "Bow Bells" at St Mary le Bow, and the "Jubilee Bells" which were originally hung on a barge on the River Thames and rung during the Queen's Jubilee pageant. They also had the opportunity to visit St Paul's Cathedral's ringing chamber and belfry which is rarely opened, but which was opened on this occasion especially for the young ringers taking part in the competition.

#### **Reading Room Update**

The proposals to refurbish the Reading Room and render it weatherproof again have taken a step forward. Whilst we await the outcome of our grant application towards the cost of the project, consultation with the contractor continues.

The works will hopefully begin on August 8th and be completed by the middle of September. As considerable repairs are necessary to the southern elevation and the roof, the work is being planned to minimise the impact on both pedestrian and vehicular access to Church Street during school term time. Whilst some inconvenience to hirers is inevitable, the contractor has assured us that the Reading Room should remain open for business as usual during the refurbishment.

#### **British Legion Club Update**

The Barrowby British Legion Club continues to thrive. We meet on the last Thursday monthly in the Reading Room. Although our meetings are of a "drop-in" rather than a formal format, we always welcome members old and new and endeavour to keep members up to date with current developments. At our next meeting, on 28th July, there will be a variety of pub games available (cards, dominoes) for all to enjoy.

We need to amass evidence that the car park and the beer garden have been in regular use for a number of years and, most importantly, have been accessed by vehicles for a variety of uses. Maybe this was to deliver to the bar cellar or to park a car on a regular basis when using the club. If you have memories of using the car park or the beer garden and are prepared to make a Statement of Truth to that effect please contact Phil Cupit on 07714508323 and he will tell you how you might help. The Statements of Truth will be submitted as evidence to the Land Registry as to our undisputed Right of Way to the Club's property and will support our claim to our continuing rights. This may well reduce the value of the BL's land quite substantially and make it less appealing to any potential developer. This will strengthen the possibility of purchasing the land currently owned by the national British Legion and amalgamating it with the land owned by Barrowby British Legion Club Ltd.
