## Another Packed Meeting about the New Housing Developments

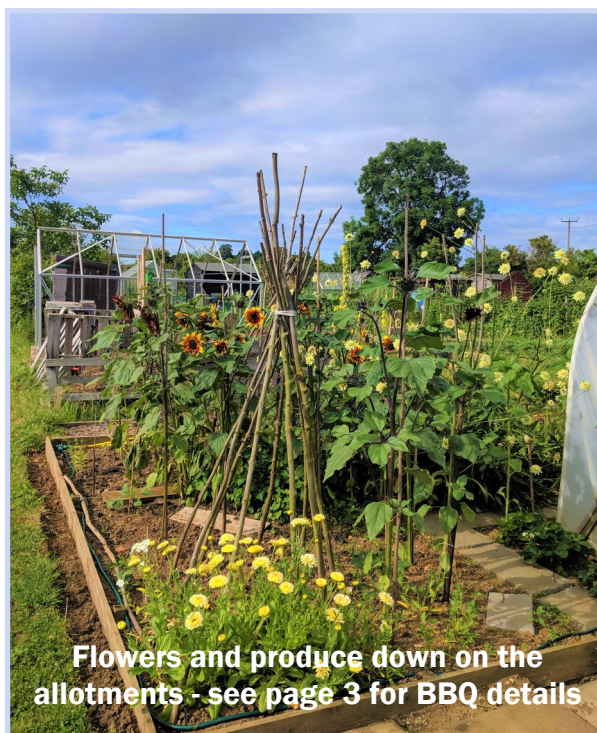
On 2nd July 85 Barrowby residents, including members of the Parish Council and the Lincs County Councillor, packed into the Memorial Hall to listen to Chair of the Parish Council, Phil Cupit; Ben Hunt, Planning Consultant; and Nigel Jones, Chair of the Neighbourhood Plan, give a very informative and useful update regarding the proposed housing developments in the village. *Read the insert to see what was said.* The next Outline Planning Permission deadline is **July 30<sup>th</sup>** (see below). If you wish to object or comment on the next planning application, read the insert about suggestions from Ben Hunt as to how you could approach this. And please contact Nigel Jones on 07801 905690 if you can help during the next stage of the Neighbourhood Plan. **Planning Application S19/1131 for 83 units: second plot deadline 30<sup>th</sup> July**

The Outline Planning Application for the **second plot** to the east of Low Road or south of Reedings Road has now been published. The closing date for comments is **30<sup>th</sup> July 2019**.

If you have any views on the Outline Planning Proposal (OPP) you must submit them to the Local Planning Authority (LPP), South Kesteven District Council, by 30<sup>th</sup> July either by post or e-mail. The original proposal was for 40 dwelling units, the OPP is **for 83 units !!!** This means that the notional numbers of 49 and 40 = 89 is now 49 + 83 = **132**. Plot 3 is yet to be applied for.

If you disagree with the proposed development, you must make sure your comments contain the word **"OBJECTION" or "AGAINST"**. If you agree with the proposal, please comment accordingly. The details of the proposal can be found by searching "South Kesteven Planning and entering "South of Reedings Road Barrowby", or once on the South Kesteven Planning page enter **S19/1131** in the search box. There are a number of documents/maps etc. for you to consider. Further information will be published on the Barrowby Parish Council web site as it becomes available.

For more about what to consider when making your comments, read the insert which gives pointers which the Planning Consultant outlined at the meeting.

**Dog Poo Bag dispensers: for emergencies only please**

In an effort to keep our village clean and safe, the Parish Council took the decision to provide dog poo bags in dispensers in key dog walking areas around the village.

In the last 6 months, the consumption of these dog poo bags has rocketed, with more than **8,000 bags** being taken from the dispensers between February and May. At this rate of usage, the cost of refilling the dispensers becomes unsustainable and it falls upon every household paying Council Tax within the village.

The Council would like to establish its expectation that dog owners **purchase and carry their own dog poo bags** and that those provided in the village dispensers are used for emergencies only. In this way, we hope to be able to retain this vital service to the community. Thank you.
