NEIGHBOURHOOD PLAN

Work on the Neighbourhood Plan is being slowed down by Covid-19 restrictions but is focussing on developing a Neighbourhood Profile, following the successful village walk-about in March.

Lindum Home's application to change the Outline Planning Permission on Low Road from a development of 49 mixed houses to be 49 affordable homes without garages and a retail unit will be considered by SKDC at a virtual Planning Committee in early June. We do not yet know the date. We have considerable reservations about the proposals both in principle and detail – the proposals are out of scale and character for a village, being intended for towns. PARISH COUNCIL

The Parish Council has resumed its monthly public meetings which, for the time being, will take place via Zoom video conferencing. Zoom is free and easy to use on a pc, laptop, tablet or mobile.
