

#### BARROWBY MIGHT WANT A SHOP - BUT IS THIS THE RIGHT PLACE WITH THE RIGHT VISUAL IMPACT?

Residents affected will have received a letter from the Neighbourhood Plan and Barrowby Parish Council suggesting that the planning application is **REJECTED** with reasons why. If **you** want a copy contact Nigel on 07713 621672 or <u>n.jones23@btinternet.com</u>. There are **three** main concerns:

- 1. Parking on Low Road towards The Drift. No-one will use a car park behind a shop.
- 2. **Additional traffic** through the village. The stated intention is to **attract** customers from beyond the village by putting the shop front on the road unlike in Ancaster, Colsterworth or Long Bennington.
- **3. Ugly visual impact**: orange roof, bright lights, no sensitivity of the surroundings, disproportionate size, **much** larger than the houses, no net bio-diversity.
