BARROWBY GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION

Tips for the weeks ahead:

- Sow winter lettuce and plant spring cabbage. Sow carrots under glass or cloches (Amsterdam forcing)
- Clear away any crops that have finished producing, such as summer cabbage and peas and keep weeds under control
- Turn any compost bins over ready for winter to help air circulation
- When cropping has finished in the greenhouse, disinfect the inside glass and structure to prevent any issues for the coming year
- Start planning the next growing season, thinking of crop rotation and what is required. Start looking to see what seeds are available.
