MAKE YOUR VIEWS KNOWN! TWO IMPORTANT CONSULTATIONS INCLUDED WITH THIS ISSUE

The Parish Council has to prepare its annual budget for 2023/24 by December 2022. They face a number of challenges in producing a balanced budget and are conscious of the financial situation that every household faces in the coming months. As difficult decisions will have to be made, the Parish Council wishes to consult parishioners to identify the perceived priorities of the community, and to establish whether cuts to services or increases in precept, or a combination of both, is an acceptable way forward. The enclosed questionnaire outlines the issues facing the Parish Council and how you can make your views known.

The second leaflet is from Allison Homes, the developers responsible for the third phase of development off Low Road (south of the Scout Hut). There appears to be a genuine desire to consult with residents of the village to explain what is proposed and to seek your views and suggestions as to how the scheme might be enhanced. They will be holding a consultation and exhibition in the Reading Room on Wednesday 14th December between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m.

Please take the opportunity to make your views known by engaging with both of these consultations.

Please remember you also have an opportunity to meet your Parish Councillors on the last Saturday of every month, in the Reading Room 10 – 12 noon. **Next session Saturday 26th November.** Come and join Parish Councillors and representatives of other village organisations for a friendly chat over refreshments. The next session will be after the Christmas break, on 29th January 2023.

Since taking over the running of Barrowby Post office in early 2019, Jen has worked really hard to extend the range of services she can offer the village.

As well as buying stamps and postal orders, and sending letters and parcels, did you know that you can:

- Withdraw cash from your bank account from most high street/online bank accounts
- Deposit cash and pay in cheques (with a paying in slip) to most high street/online bank accounts
- Buy Euros
- Top up your Mobile Phone
- Top up Gas and Electric
- Pay bills, such as Council Tax and energy bills (some companies do charge, so check this first)
- Buy a fishing licence
- Process online shopping returns that have Royal Mail or Parcelforce return labels
- Process online letters and parcels
- Buy Amazon and One4All Multi-Store Gift cards

In addition, Jenny keeps a well-stocked shop, with

- Newspapers, magazines and stationery items
- Fresh bread and other items from Bloomsbury Bakery, delivered 3 times a week
- Local Grantham Gingerbread products
- Baldertons dry cleaning services collecting twice a week (Tuesday and Friday)
- Homemade jams and chutneys all made from locally grown produce
- A selection of store cupboard essentials, including a wide range of confectionery, milk, tinned and packet foods, biscuits, cleaning products and much more
- A selection of greetings cards
- A wide range of handcrafted items, most of which can be personalised.

BARROWBY GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION - TIPS FOR DECEMBER

- * Sow broad beans, with protection, for an early crop.
- * Start winter digging when ground conditions are favourable.
- * Clean greenhouse glass and frames.
- * Start winter pruning of apples and pears but not cherries, plums or damsons.
- * Clean gladioli corms and save only the ones that do not show signs of mould.
- * Prepare sweet pea planting area by applying 3-4 handfuls of bone meal per sq yd onto the top surface.


