Not only is wool used for clothing, but you can also get pillows, duvets and even mattresses made of wool, which, of course, is totally natural, sustainable and hypoallergenic! They demonstrated some of the different ways to use this wonderful material and invited anyone interested to join them in their free workshops to try spinning and weaving and generally creating things for themselves. It was a really fascinating evening.


