They heard about how Anne started off being given one lamb from a farmer, to building up to a flock of 220 breeding sheep! Not only is wool used for clothing, but you can also get pillows, duvets and even mattresses made of wool, which, of course, is totally natural, sustainable and hypoallergenic! They demonstrated some of the different ways to use this wonderful material and invited anyone interested to join them in their free workshops to try spinning and weaving and generally creating things for themselves. It was a really fascinating evening.

The June meeting is being held jointly with Harlaxton WI, with Harlaxton hosting the event this year. The speaker will be Rev. Geraldine Pond.
