DEFRA ADVICE ON AVIAN FLU IN THE NG32 AREA

If you find any dead waterfowl, or other dead wild birds such as gulls or birds of prey, you should not touch them, but report them to the Defra Helpline, on 03459 335577.

There is specific advice for anyone keeping poultry or game birds, or other birds as pets.

Such birds have to be registered.

You can register your birds by calling 03300 416589 (Mon-Fri 08:30 -17:00), or by completing and returning the form which accompanied the letter to households.

BARROWBY STREET SCENE

The Clerk to the Parish Council sometimes receives anonymous complaints about the condition of the roads around the village, or overhanging hedges obstructing public footpaths. A letter can be sent from the Parish Council to householders asking them to cut back hedges. However responsibility for highways and footpaths belongs to the Highways Division at Lincolnshire County Council. Residents can report potholes or badly damaged roads, overhanging trees or hedges, blocked drains and other issues online at https://fixmystreet.lincolnshire.gov.uk/ report. Reports with photographs of the problem attached are dealt with much quicker.

BARROWBY GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION - WINTER GARDENING TIPS

Continue to collect fallen leaves. A good way to save them for mulching is to place into a large plastic bag and pierce with holes in the base, keep topping up as you collect more leaves.

Lawns - keep spiking and aerating, brush off

any worm casts.

Raise any containers with plants on to bricks or other raised supports to allow free drainage: move to a sheltered place if possible.

Weather permitting, dig a trench and place green waste in ready for runner beans. Finish planting garlic.
