Passengers familiar with the Call Connect bus journey system now have a new way of managing their bookings. The flexible, on-demand booking app is smart and easy to use with more control to book, track and manage your Callconnect rides anytime of the day. All passengers need to do is simply download the app and register details. To book a ride just select the pickup and drop off points and let the app do the rest. Customers who are currently registered with Callconnect will receive a letter in the post with more detail and information.

FOCUS ON MOVE IT 2 MUSIC

GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS

Sow sweet peas for early flowering. Lift gladioli, cut stems to 25mm and store in a frost free place.

Lift chrysanthemums and place in a cold frame or green house.

Lift dahlias when blackened by frost and store in a frost free place.

Disinfect greenhouse inside and clean outside glass. Plant spring cabbage and winter lettuce and plant winter onion sets.

If possible turn composting bin to help quicken the waste cycle.




