GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS

- Sow spring cabbage seeds.
- Sow lettuce for early winter use.
- Pinch out the top of tomato plants when they have reached the desired height. At the end of the month stop feeding them.
- Start picking early apples and pears while under ripe.
- Pick loganberries and cut back fruited shoots, tie in new growth.
- Plant strawberry runners.
- Keep cutting sweet pea flowers, and don't let them form pods or it will reduce the flowering period.


