Firstly, I must take the time to congratulate our fantastic "Barrowby in Bloom" volunteers for winning the SKDC Community In Bloom Award 2023!! This has been a great community initiative and I hope we can have many more community led initiatives as the parish continues to expand and grow.

We continue to have dialogue with the builders about the three new developments within the Parish - two of these are on Low Road and the third is on Barrowby Road opposite the Colleys. Our ongoing battles with SKDC, to secure some funds towards much needed facilities in the village, are well documented in the Grantham Journal, and continue to be 'challenging'. However we have a face to face meeting coming up where we hope we can find some resolution. In particular we are seeking to ensure they provide safe pedestrian, cycle and transport routes.

### BARROWBY FLOWER VOLUNTEERS REWARDED WITH COMMUNITY IN BLOOM AWARD

The volunteers who make up Barrowby Flowers have this year given freely of their time and energy to plant and maintain Barrowby's flowerbeds and other public areas.

Their efforts have been rewarded with SKDC's Community in Bloom award, which has replaced Best Kept Village. The village nomination praised the efforts of former parish council chair Phil Cupit, who gathered a group of hard-working volunteers willing to donate plants and give up their time to help Barrowby bloom again.

The judges considered photographs of the planters, flower beds, hanging baskets etc. and described them as 'spectacular.'

### **SCOUT CHRISTMAS POST 2023**



The Scout Post is back again for Christmas 2023, with stamps remaining at a cost of 25p. Stamps will be on sale from 20<sup>th</sup>

Having made it to within 1200 metres of the summit, unfortunately Paula was taken ill, and had to be taken back down the mountain and then to hospital.

Thankfully she made a full recovery, and despite being really disappointed at not making it to the very top, Paula is thankful for the care she received, and for the sponsorship of so many people. To date her effort has raised £4070 for Dementia UK.

### **GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS**

Clean Gladioli corms.

Remove any bulblets and store corms in separate paper bags, remembering

to label.

Prepare next year's sweet pea site, ideally North to South. Apply bone meal to top surface. Complete planting of tulips and hyacinths. Wash Greenhouse glass to add valuable light. November is usually the best time to plant fruit. Complete winter digging for next year's vegetables and plan your crop rotation. Lift any fuchsias, begonias, geraniums and other tender plants.
