PARISH COUNCIL UPDATE FROM THE CHAIR

It is always nice to have some good news to share, however small. I am pleased to confirm that the Post Office have returned the Westry Corner post box.

British Legion site.

I would like to share an update on our continued efforts to secure the former Royal British Legion site for a new community facility. We recently met with representatives of the National British Legion who outlined their objectives. It is clear they seek to maximise the potential value of the site by reclassifying it as suitable for residential development. Should this be achieved it could put the cost of the site out of our reach. We will of course seek to prevent this as it is not at all in line with the original terms of the transfer of the land.

Parish Survey.

Thank you to everyone who completed the Parish survey. We had a good level of response and your answers will help to guide the development of our Neighbourhood Plan, including leisure requirements and the use of our green spaces. We will hold a Public meeting before the end of the year to present the results/findings.

SKDC BATTERY DISPOSAL SCHEME

To encourage households to recycle batteries, and to reduce the risk of fires in bin lorries, a recycling scheme has been introduced by SKDC.

If you have household batteries to recycle, place them in a small bag such as a new freezer bag or a nappy sack and tie the bag to the lid of your black, silver or purple-lid wheelie bin on collection day each week. (This does not include vapes, disposable or otherwise, and certain larger types of battery). This service is available every week to all residential addresses with a wheelie bin, with the battery bags emptied into a separate container attached to each bin lorry. There is no extra cost to householders for

- Lift dahlias when frosted.
- Lift gladioli and complete spring bulb planting.
- It is also a good time to clean pots and tubs, and wipe off writing on labels ready for the new growing season.
- Fruits such as raspberries and blackberries need cutting back.
- A good time to prune blackcurrant, redcurrant and gooseberry bushes.


