PAVILION COMMITTEE - UPDATE ON CAR PARK

Earlier this year the Parish Council was invited to apply for a grant to the Councillor Volunteer Scheme, run by Lincolnshire County Council. The Council was successful in its request with a grant to repair the potholes in the Pavilion car park. Volunteers from Balfour Beatty and Toppesfield carried out the work just after Easter. The Parish Council would like to thank all the volunteers for their hard work, which will make a big difference to the entrance and parking area and improve the safety of our Community.

ORCHARDS IN BARROWBY

SKDC has successfully applied to the Coronation Living Heritage Fund to create new orchards in the county. Barrowby Parish Council has resolved to consider applying for up to

£1,500 towards the planting of a minimum of five fruit trees on publicly accessible sites in the village.

ALLOTMENTS

Currently there is a waiting list for allotments. Plots are allocated in order of application, and preference is given first to Barrowby residents, then existing plot holders, then non Barrowby residents.

Produce is not sold from the allotments but when excess produce is available the association can ask for donations.

GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS FOR MAY

April is a busy time of the year for fruit, veg and flowers.

- Sow salad seed crops. For lettuce Little Gem is a quick growing variety and is compact even for a garden border.

- In the greenhouse outdoor tomato seeds can be sown, as well as cucumber and melon.
- Plant late season strawberries and keep a check on fruit tree blossom.
- Plant healthy dahlia tubers and plant spring sown sweet peas.
- Many herbs and hardy annual seeds can be sown outdoors by the end of the month.
