GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS FOR JUNE



Sow runner and french beans, beetroot, peas and spring onion.

Sow lettuce and radish for a continuous supply.

Winter cabbage and broccoli and calabrese can be sown.

Watch out for late frosts on potatoes and be prepared to fleece.

Plant out brussel sprouts, summer cabbage and leeks.

In the Greenhouse plant or place pots of peppers, chilli, cucumber and tomatoes.

Plant out chrysanthemums and young Dahlias when danger of frost has passed.

Tidy up daffodils and tulips by dead heading and lift when they have died off.

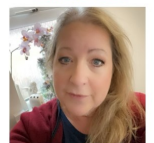
