PARISH COUNCIL - NEWS FOR 2024 From Nigel Eaton, Chair

It has been a busy period for the Parish Council. Financial prudence over the past year has stopped the drain on reserves and allowed the Parish Council to set a sensible precept for the 2024 Financial Year. There will be a rise of 5% as we



continue to keep pace with inflation and rising costs: this equates to an annual increase of £3.48 on a Band D house.

One area where the Parish Council seeks to save money is on unnecessary repairs to the play equipment on the green. It is a children's play area, not built for adults; but with adults regularly unable to resist the temptation the equipment simply cannot handle the weight. Repairs in the 2023/24 financial year ran to £6,500. The Parish Council does not want to be put in a position where they are forced to remove the play equipment because of frequent damage, making it no longer economically viable.

Annual Parish Meeting

Please put Thursday 23rd May (evening) in your diary for the Annual Parish Meeting. The Parish Council would like to have all the local clubs and societies represented there, as well as our local District and County Councillors. The Parish Council will also ask the construction companies planning new housing developments within the Parish to come along to answer any questions.

Community Speed Watch

The Village has completed the first training session for Community Speed Watch - thank you to those of you who attended. This initiative empowers communities to proactively take steps to reduce the nuisance of speeding traffic on our roads. We will soon be putting up new signage and organising speed checks. With the weather improving, it's time to dust off those walking boots and get out and about in the Barrowby area (and beyond!).

Visit the Parish Council website for details of over a dozen local walks, which all take in features of interest or offer stunning vistas. The walks are designed to cater for all abilities and interests.

There are also 2 Barrowby Heritage Walks, accompanied by extensive historic and interesting information. Heritage Walk-1 is a leisurely 2 mile stroll around the historic core of the village, taking in the listed buildings and visible remains of the medieval agricultural heart of the parish.

Heritage Walk-2, at 6.5 miles, reaches Grantham Canal.

GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS FOR APRIL

It's a busy time in April on the plot or in the garden, weather permitting!

- Time to plant early potatoes, and second early at the end of the month. Also shallots and onion sets: shallots at the beginning and onions by the end of the month.
- Broad bean seeds can be planted along with early seeds. Grow a round seed at the beginning, and later in the month an ordinary variety.
- Parsnip seeds can be sown: sow 3 seeds together and thin out to one when shooting. Always use new seeds.
- Sow summer cabbage seeds and lettuce.
- Start to sow tomato seeds sow thinly and over a few weeks, this way it gives a longer picking season.
- Marigold seed can be sown, a good companion in the greenhouse to the tomatoes.
- Check flower seeds for sowing dates, as it is the start of the season for many.
- Cuttings of chrysanthemums can be taken and gladioli corms can be planted.
