PARISH NEWS

BARROWBY NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING GROUP - UPDATE FROM CHAIR PHIL CUPIT

Work progresses apace towards the completion of our Neighbourhood Plan. We commissioned AECOM, using government grants, to conduct a Design Code and Housing Needs Assessment for Barrowby. These reports are at the point of being signed off and will soon be able to provide an evidence base for the proposed policies for future development within the village.

Housing Needs Assessment.

The good news is that, on balance, there should be no further need for additional housing within the parish before 2040 once the existing proposed developments have been completed.

Design Codes

There are identifiable areas of the village with key similarities in building type and style, and proposed policy issues have been forthcoming to ensure that future development is in line with the style and finish of existing dwellings.

Both of these documents will be made available on the Parish Council website for everyone to access. The proposed Neighbourhood Plan will be put out to consultation at draft stage, so that amendments might be considered before it is examined by the Local Planning Inspector and becomes part of the referendum within the parish.

running in the London Marathon on Sunday April 21st for this very special charity. His training is well under way,



GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS

- Try planting early potatoes in tubs and place them in a greenhouse.
- Sow sweet peas outdoors late in the month in their flowering position, or in pots.
- Sow summer lettuce and cabbage under glass.
- Sow peppers and chilli peppers under glass and preferably with heat.
- Sow broad beans and early round peas.
- Sow onion seeds and plant shallots towards the end of the month.
- Last chance to prune apples and pears before the sap starts to rise.
