Programmes for the scarecrow trail and garage sale sites will be available to buy all weekend from the Barrowby News team. The reverse of the programme will include your voting form for your choice of best scarecrow. The winner will be announced on Sunday afternoon.

The weekend promises to have something for everyone to enjoy. On Saturday from 10:00 a.m. onwards, come along and find activities such as the Summer Market, where you will be able to support lots of local independent sellers and charity stalls, alongside the usual book sale, tombola and raffle. Make a shaker with the Pre-School team, join in activities with the church. Pick up a programme and look out for the garage sales along the scarecrow route - and get voting for your favourite scarecrow. Saturday evening brings live music and a DJ!

Sunday is Family Day with lots of fun attractions for all ages. The miniature donkeys will be back for a second year; the Grantham Archers will be running 'have a go' archery; there will be bouncy castles, vintage fairground rides, demonstrations in martial arts, wool spinning and the British Legion Riders. There will be bubble tea and fizz, live music from lunchtime into the evening, and much more.

<u>All weekend</u> there will be face painting, a caricaturist, hot food traders, ice creams and a licensed bar from Bar Zest.
