#### **BARROWBY PARISH COUNCIL**

The Parish Council received a strong expression of interest from residents in response to last month's item about a possible visit to the newly discovered round houses site. Options are being discussed with the developers, but currently the state of the ground prevents any visits at present on health and safety grounds.

Further information about the progress of the excavations will be shared with residents as soon as it becomes available.

#### **VILLAGE BIODIVERSITY PROJECT GETS UNDERWAY**

The Parish Recreation and Greenspace group has started work on its 'Making Space for Nature Project' with funding from SKDC and the Parish Council. Volunteers have dug a trench ready for a new hedge in the burial ground. The native species trees, chosen for their wildlife value, will be planted shortly.

The group have taken delivery of four purpose built 'bug hotels' to install on village greenspaces in the early spring. They are also awaiting delivery of around 60 bird and bat boxes, again to go up around various greenspaces around Barrowby.

There is a community bird box building event being planned for the Easter weekend – please look out for further details in the next issue of the News!

#### **GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS**

After all the cold, damp weather of January and February, March will hopefully be a good time to start some spring gardening jobs.



- \* Control moss in the lawn by aeration with a wire rake and cut the grass when it's about 7cm long.
- \* Start off sweet peas in pots or better still root trainers as they produce long roots.
- \* Plant fruit trees and bushes.
- \* For the veg plot sow lettuce, radish, parsnip and plant out shallots.
- \* Start off brassicas, e.g. cabbage, Brussel sprouts and an early cauliflower variety.
- \* For the greenhouse start sowing tomatoes and cucumber, and it's also not too late for peppers.
- \* Try sowing some dill it's nice when added to lettuce.
- \* You can start off geranium seeds, but plug plants are a far better way of growing them.


