# NEIGHBOURHOOD PLANNING GROUP - PUBLIC CONSULTATION MEETING FRIDAY 21ST FEBRUARY

The draft Neighbourhood Plan and its associated evidence base will be published on the Parish Council website on <u>Friday 14<sup>th</sup> February.</u> This will be accessible at <u>www.barrowbyparishcouncil.org.uk</u>

All residents of Barrowby are invited to the public consultation meeting.

"The Barrowby Neighbourhood Plan is an important planning document which will shape the future of our community over the next decade and beyond. It is relevant to all parishioners and those who value our long history, heritage and sense of community." At the public meeting you can find out how you can have your say re comments/ amendments before the final version of the plan is published for consideration by SKDC and the Planning Inspectorate. Later in the year the finalised plan will be subject to a local referendum, held by SKDC. This will be the opportunity for the village to decide whether the proposed plan represents a suitable way forward for the future development of Barrowby.

#### **BARROWBY PARISH COUNCIL - UPDATE FROM CHAIR**

I wanted to use this opportunity to update you all on some recent local developments. Firstly, huge congratulations to the team of Barrowby residents who, working with the Parish Council's 'Green Space and Recreation Working Group' have been awarded funding from South Kesteven District Council's 'Make Space for Nature' scheme. The biodiversity project will see more than 60 bird, bat, and habitat boxes pop up across the village. We will also be holding a community event in March where you can make your own bird nest box to install at home in your garden, so look out for further details coming soon!

Secondly, as reported in last month's Barrowby News, the new development on Low Road has (literally) unearthed some very interesting historical finds, and if there is sufficient interest the developers have offered to conduct some site tours to view the Iron Age Roundhouse excavations.






