GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION TIPS FOR JULY

- On the plot: harvest new potatoes and summer salads and broad beans, strawberries and summer raspberries.
- Sow beetroot, French beans and round varieties of peas.
- Lift shallots and dry.
- Water your plot as often as possible to help growth and prevent bolting.
- Feed greenhouse tomatoes and cucumbers.
- Pinch out any side shoots on tomatoes if growing cordon varieties, and use shading if in full sun.
- Thin out apples and pears if you have a bumper crop.
- Water lawns in very dry weather and aerate the surface.
- Stake dahlias and gladioli.
- Lift and store tulips and daffodils.
