Minutes of the Barrowby Burial Ground Committee Meeting held on Friday 14th October 2022 at the Reading Room, Barrowby at 12.30pm

There were no members of the public present.

1. WELCOME REMARKS (22/011)

1.1 The Chairman welcomed members to the meeting and thanked them for their attendance. Those in attendance were Councillors Cupit, Brown, Lees, Townsend and the Clerk Mrs J Moss.

2. APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE (22/012)

3. TO RECEIVE DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST AND REQUESTS FOR DISPENSATION IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE LOCALISM ACT 2011 (22/013)

3.1 None received.

4. APPROVAL OF MINUTES (22/014)

- 4.1 The Clerk's minutes of the Burial Ground Committee meeting held on 15th July 2022, having been proposed by Councillor Brown and seconded by Councillor Lees, were agreed to be a true and accurate record and were passed unanimously by the committee. There was one abstention.
- 4.2 Members noted that not all actions have been completed. Councillor Lees provided an update on the seeding of the wildflower area and **Councillor Cupit will review the forms and send to the Clerk.**

5. BURIAL GROUND UPDATE (22/015)

- 5.1 Members noted that there has been one double ashes interment in the Burial Ground since the previous meeting.
- 5.2 Members discussed the quotes received to cut back the fallen willow tree and following a proposal by Councillor Lees, seconded by Councillor Brown agreed which Contractor to use dependant on getting copy of relevant qualifications.
 - Action: Clerk to obtain details of qualifications from preferred Contractor to conduct tree work.
- 5.3 Members discussed the quotes to replace the fence at the Burial Ground.
 - Action: Councillor Lees to discuss with one Contractor his quote and let the Committee know the outcome by email.
- 5.4 Following a proposal by Councillor Cupit, seconded by Councillor Lees, members resolved to approve the provision of plots for pauper's graves in the south east corner of the Burial Ground.
- 5.5 Members agreed to discuss the new plan of the available plots in the consecrated area at the next meeting.
 - Action: Clerk to add to Agenda for next meeting.
- 5.6 Members discussed the contents of an email received regarding maintenance of a headstone and agreed the wording of the response.

6. CONSECRATION OF ADDITIONAL AREA (22/016)

6.1 Following a proposal by Councillor Lees, seconded by Councillor Brown, members resolved to not to go ahead and consecrate an additional area in the Burial Ground.

7. BURIAL GROUND CHARGES (22/017)

- 7.1 Following a proposal by Councillor Cupit, seconded by Councillor Brown, members resolved to approve an increase in the charges for grave digging. There was one abstention.
- 7.2 Following a proposal by Councillor Lees, seconded by Councillor Cupit, members resolved to

approve charges for wider plots and preparation of legal documentation.

Action: Clerk to put proposals to the Parish Council at the next Parish Council meeting.

8. BURIAL GROUND PROCESSES (22/018)

8.1 Councillor Cupit expressed his displeasure that the complaint was discussed at a Parish Council meeting and that his name had been mentioned without him being present.

Members reviewed the Burial Ground processes following the receipt of a complaint and the Parish Council response and agreed that in future all legal documents and financial matters should be dealt with by the Clerk.
