Households within the village will have received a leaflet inviting you to comment on the further housing developments proposed for Barrowby.

South Kesteven District Council (SKDC) are currently consulting on their draft Local Plan.

A new site has been proposed for Barrowby SKPR-327. This site on Westry Corner/The Drift is for 455 homes. Together with SKPR-272 on Low Road this will be 725! SKDC wish to add this site for development within 5 Years

The Parish Council's greatest concerns are the sheer number of new houses and the reduced time scale, 0—5 years.

If you wish to comment on this proposal all comments must be submitted to SKDC by **Thursday 28th August 2025.** 



#### **DID YOU KNOW?...**

Along Casthorpe Road, past the current houses, there is a seat on the right hand side. This was the site of Barrowby's parish water pump – it was a force pump and led to an overhead pipe (similar to the one at Croxton Kerrial) so that carts and steam engines could get underneath to get a water supply.




# GARDENERS' ASSOCIATION: TIPS FOR SEPTEMBER

#### ON THE PLOT

- Purchase sweet pea seeds for sowing in October.
- Sow lettuce for overwintering, using cloche protection.
- Lift carrots and store in deep boxes with layers
   of dry sand.
- Plant spring cabbage.
- Under glass or in a polytunnel, sow Amsterdam Forcing carrot seeds.
- Sow broad beans for an early crop.
- Prune old shoots of blackberry, loganberry, and
   all hybrid berries, replacing them with new shoots for next year's crop.
- Prune plum and damson trees once picking is complete.
- Complete summer pruning of pears and apples.

#### IN THE GARDEN





- Clip new growth on hedges for the last time; plant new hedges from mid-September.
- Continue watering tubs and containers, and remove fading flowers.
- Do not overwater houseplants as days become cooler and shorter.
  - Keep weeds under control in borders and remove any annual plants that are past their best.
  - Fork over borders in preparation for the coming winter.
